Entries

Completed entry forms should be returned, with the relevant fee and sent by **special delivery** to ensure receipt, to the National Events Administrator, 41 Granby Street, Loughborough, Leics. LE11 3DU. If you require confirmation of receipt of entry please enclose a stamped self addressed postcard (this is not a confirmation of entry).

All entries must be received in the National Events Office by 5.00pm on 20th June 2007 (The closing date). Entries received in the post after this date will be rejected regardless of the date posted. Entries sent without fee, entries incorrectly completed and improved entries will not be accepted. Entry to the Boys 800m & Girls 1500m Freestyle will be by invitation, issued after the last qualifying meet, based on swimmers entered in the British Swimming Ranking System. A maximum of 50 swimmers will be invited for each event with a minimum of 10 from each individual age group; Girls 11-13 years & Boys 12-14 years, entry forms will be sent and these should be returned forthwith with the relevant fee.

Cheques and Post Orders should be made payable to the 'ASA' and crossed.

Please enclose an A4 Stamped Addressed Envelope for the return of your entry confirmation.

PLEASE NOTE ENTRY CARDS WILL NOT BE ISSUED FOR THIS EVENT.

Reserves and Withdrawals

Withdrawals from heats must be notified to the National Events Administrator 14 days prior to the start of the competition. Under exceptional circumstances only withdrawals on the day of competition may be accepted by the Meet Director, these must be notified to the Chief Recorder on the official form no later than 60 minutes prior to the start of the appropriate heats session. Individuals failing to comply shall be fined £10.00 and Teams shall be fined £100.00 for each inappropriate withdrawal. (See Event Conditions)

A maximum of two reserves will be declared for finals. Withdrawals from finals must be made within 30 minutes of the conclusion of the heats for the last individual event, in the session from which the swimmer has qualified for the final. Failure to withdraw within the stipulated time will result in a £50 fine. Failure to pay the fine will result in suspension from further events

Doping Control

Swimmers are warned that random doping control may take place during these championships. Please ensure that you bring with you to the championships your passport or other form of identity, which incorporates your photograph.

Training

Due to the large number of swimmers participating in this event, training will not be available during the age group competition. Swimmers are only permitted in the warm-up session if they are competing in that session.

Training may be available on the evening of the 22nd July further information will be posted on the British Swimming website when available.

Diving Pool

The diving pool will be available for warm-up & swim down during competition time.

Accreditation

Accreditation will be issued to a swimmer with their event confirmation. It is the swimmers own responsibility to bring their accreditation. Accreditation must be worn at all times inside the complex, swimmers will not be allowed to gain access to the pool area without it. Only one accreditation pass will be issued. If this is lost or mislaid during competition you should report to the ASA stand where a temporary day pass will be issued. Further accreditation will be issued at a charge of £5.00.

Coaches Passes/Chaperone/Physiotherapist passes

All coaches, chaperones and physiotherapists must have a valid accreditation to gain access to the pool deck.

Please note that due to the high number of entries expected for these championships, passes may be restricted, per club, dependent on the number of swimmers entered by the club.

ASA NATIONAL AGE GROUP CHAMPIONSHIPS CONDITIONS

1.0 General Conditions

- [a] The Amateur Swimming Association Technical Swimming Committee reserves full powers over all ASA Championships. The Executive Director shall act as Promoter for the event.
- [b] The Championships shall be held at a venue and for a period determined by the Committee.
- [c] The Championships shall be competed for annually under the Laws of the Association, the Technical Rules of FINA and any additional conditions published in the Meet Information.
- [d] Entries may only be accepted from competitors registered as members of the ASA, SASA or WASA, or competitors from one of the countries affiliated to FINA. Where required to do so, competitors shall present their passport for age verification to the ASA National Events Administrator not later than 15:00 hours on the day before the Championships begin.
- [f] A competitor must have been a registered member, or equivalent, of the club in whose name he is entered, at least 60 days prior to the first day of the Championships.
- [g] Individuals forming the teams must have been registered members of the club, at least 60 days prior to the first day of the Championships.

2.0 The Events

[a] *British Age Group Categories [BAGCATS]*

Girls – 11, 12 & 13 years

Boys – 11, 12, 13 & 14 years

- [b] Ages at midnight on 26th July 2007 for individual & team events.

[c] *Individual Events:*

100m, 200m, 400m, 800m 1500m Freestyle (800m & 1500m not Boys 11 years)

100m & 200m Backstroke, Breaststroke & Butterfly

200m & 400m Individual Medley

- [d] Time trials will not be permitted.

- [e] All events, except 800m & 1500m Freestyle, shall have heats and a final with the 10 fastest competitors from each age group competing.

- [f] The 800m & 1500m Freestyle shall be Heat Declared Winner [HDW] events – will be seeded at the start of the session and all heats will be swum in the same session. All swimmers in the 800m & 1500m Freestyle must declare their intention to compete to the Chief Recorder prior to the start of the warm-up.

- [g] 11 year boys who qualify for a 200m form stroke event will be given the opportunity to compete in the corresponding 100m event.

[h] *Team Events.*

Girls: 11-13 years & Boys 11-14 years: 4 x 100m Medley, 4 x 100m Freestyle and 4 x 200m Freestyle.

3.0 Entries

- [a] All entries shall be received by the ASA National Events Administrator by the relevant closing date accompanied by the appropriate entry fee. All competitors must have equalled or bettered the entry time in an event designated or licensed by the ASA, SASA or WASA or, for foreign competitors, in a competition approved by their Federation.

British Competitors in the Boys 800m & Girls 1500m Freestyle will be invited to compete immediately after the closing date, having regard to their ranked time in the British Swimming Ranking System. A maximum of 50 swimmers will be invited for each event with a minimum of 10 from each individual age group; Girls 11-13 years & Boys 12-14 years.

- [b] Entry times achieved in a 50m pool will be accepted as submitted. Times achieved in any other length of pool will be accepted as 25m short course times with NO conversions allowed. Only times achieved in a 50m pool will be accepted for the Boys/Girls 800m & 1500m Freestyle.

- [c] The ASA National Events Administrator may request validation of any stated entry time.

- [d] Entry times must have been achieved between the 1st October 2006 and 31st May 2007 or any ASA Regional events held in June 2007.

- [e] Competitors who qualify for both the ASA National Age Group Championships and the ASA Youth Championships may only enter one of the competitions. However, competitors who meet the qualifying criteria, may participate in the ASA National Long Course Championships but in doing so, they will only be able to swim in the consolidated heats and in the ASA National Long Course Championship semi-finals and finals. They will not be able to participate in the Youth finals.

- [f] Competitors whose entries have been accepted will be expected to swim unless they have complied with the withdrawal procedure.

4.0 Team Events

- [a] Only clubs affiliated to the ASA, SASA or WASA may enter the team relay events. Entry will be as a result of performance achieved at the English Regional Age Group Championships (or equivalent Scottish or Welsh Nationals), where qualifying rounds will be held.

- [b] A swimmer entered in the name of one club in the individual events may not compete in the name of another club in the team events.

- [c] The fastest 30 teams will be accepted into the 4 x 100m events and the fastest 20 teams into the 4 x 200m Freestyle event irrespective of English Region, Scotland or Wales. In the event of equal times being submitted for the final available place, a ballot will determine. The names of 2 reserve teams will be published.

- [d] Clubs must confirm their invitation to compete to the ASA National Events Administrator within 7 days of receiving their invitation. Failure to do so may result in their invitation being withdrawn.

- [e] Clubs must complete a team declaration form, which must be handed to the Recorders at least 60 minutes before the start of the session in which the relevant team event takes place. Teams not complying with this instruction will lose their automatic right to compete.

(f) Where a club has more than one team in an event, a swimmer who has been declared for one team may not compete for another team in the same event.

5.0 **Meet Procedure**

[a] Swimmers with 50m long course pool entry times shall be placed in graduated time order, slowest to fastest. Swimmers with entry times from other pool lengths will have their entries placed at the start of the event with no swimmer being seeded faster than one with a 50m pool entry time.

[b] There shall be an interval of not less than 30 minutes between the last heat and the final for that event.

[c] In the finals 10 finalists and 2 reserves will be selected. Only two foreign swimmers will be allowed to progress to the final. For this purpose a foreign swimmer will be defined as a swimmer who has not declared their eligibility to represent Great Britain.

6.0 **Withdrawals**

[a] Competitors must notify the ASA National Events Administrator of their withdrawal from an event 14 days prior to the start of the competition.

[b] Under exceptional circumstances only, withdrawals on the day of the Championship may be accepted by the Meet Director. However, these must then be notified to the Chief Recorder, on the relevant form, not later than 60 minutes prior to the start of the appropriate heats session. Competitors failing to comply shall be fined £10 for each inappropriate withdrawal. If a team fails to notify the Chief Recorder of their withdrawal, the Club they represent shall be fined the sum of £100.

[c] Finalists and reserve finalists (individuals and teams) shall declare to the Chief Recorder, within 30 minutes of the last individual event in that session, if they intend to withdraw from an event. The withdrawal shall be made on the official withdrawal form.

[d] Competitors or teams withdrawing on medical grounds after the expiry of the imposed deadlines shall have their withdrawal endorsed by the Championship Medical Officer or the Meet Director.

[e] An individual competitor shall be fined the sum of £50 if they fail to notify the Chief Recorder of a withdrawal within the stipulated time. If a team fails to notify the Chief Recorder of a withdrawal within the stipulated time, the Club they represent shall be fined the sum of £100.

[f] Any competitor withdrawing from a final in such a manner as to prevent a reserve from taking part (except in the case of genuine illness endorsed by the Championship Medical Officer or of a proven emergency) shall be fined £50. Where a reserve is brought in at short notice, the reserve shall occupy the vacant lane and there will be no amendments made to the allocation of other lanes.

[g] Both individual competitors and teams will be unable to take any further part in the meet, until such time as any fines levied, have been paid.

[h] All fines levied on individual competitors or teams remain the responsibility of the Club that the individuals or teams are entered under. Failure to pay any fine within 28 days of notification will result in further disciplinary action by the ASA Technical Swimming Committee.

7.0 **Trophies & Medals**

[a] Medals will be awarded to British competitors, placed first, second or third in individual or team events.

[b] Commemorative medals will be awarded to foreign competitors placed first, second or third in individual events.

[c] British age Group Category Awards [Bagcat Awards] will be determined by the use of the British Age Group Comparative Points Tables. The highest points gained from each of the Sprint, Form Stroke, Distance and Individual Medley events available to each age group shall be used to determine the category winners. Points will only be accrued from the HEATS of the events detailed below:

Girls 11, 12 & 13 years:

100m best 100m
Form Stroke best 200m
Distance best 200m, 400m, 800m or 1500m Free
Individual Medley best 200m or 400m

Boys 11, 12, 13 & 14 years

100m best 100m
Form Stroke best 200m
Distance best 200m, 400m, 800m or 1500m Free (as applicable)
Individual Medley best 200m or 400m

NB Form Stroke is defined as being Backstroke, Breaststroke or Butterfly

[d] British competitors placed 1st to 10th shall receive an award and a commemorative award will be given to Foreign Competitors finishing 1st to 3rd in their category.

[e] Presentations - the Meet Director will determine when the presentations will take place. Competitors must report to the Presentation Marshall immediately after the completion of their final. Appropriate clothing, i.e. a full tracksuit and training shoes must be worn for presentations.

[f] Awards will be made to the Top Female Club, Top Male Club and Top Overall Club based on points scoring.

Meet Procedure

After the closing date a confirmation of entry will be forwarded to you.

A draft programme will be published on the British Swimming Website on, or before, Friday 29th June 2007.

Entry confirmations should be checked thoroughly to ensure that all details are correct. Any errors, or corrections must be advised to the Entry Meet Administrator immediately at age.group@swimming.org

Swimmers must inform the Entry Meet Administrator, **no later than 9th July** of their withdrawal from an event. **Swimmers are reminded that they are only permitted to withdraw from an event after this time provided they comply with the criteria laid down in the event conditions. Failure to comply with the conditions could result in a fine.**

IN THE CASE OF THE 800 AND 1500 METRES FREESTYLE EVENTS, SWIMMERS WILL BE REQUIRED TO DECLARE THEIR INTENTION TO SWIM, BEFORE THE PUBLISHED START TIME FOR WARM UP, FOR THE PARTICULAR EVENT.

Swimmers with 50 metre long course pool entry times shall be placed in graduated time order, slowest to fastest.

Swimmers with entry times from any other pool length will have their times entered as a 25 metre short course time and shall be placed at the start of the event with no swimmer being seeded faster than one with a 50 metre pool entry time.

Boys 11 years 100m events

These events do not have a qualifying time. Entry will be open to those swimmers with a qualifying time for the corresponding 200m events. Swimmers who fall into this group, and who wish to swim in the 100m events, should enter their personal best time in the appropriate time box on the entry form.

Fifteen minutes prior to the start of the session, or one event prior to the one in which you are competing, you should present yourself, to the Competitors Steward in the Marshalling Area. This is to be found on the Omega Suite side of the pool under the Spectator Balcony.

You must not go direct to the Start.

A call room will be used for finals.
