



Conditions for Participation in the FIL LOGO HUNT

1. The International Federation of Women's Lacrosse (IFWLA) and the International Lacrosse Federation (ILF) are planning to unify as of August 2008 into one International Governing Body for Lacrosse. This new Federation will be called the **Federation of International Lacrosse (FIL)**.
2. The Transition Board (TB) of the FIL wants your help in finding an appropriate logo for the new organization. This must be suitable for use in all media types. The logo must be a graphically rendered word/image combination or graphic.
3. Further information can be found on the homepage of the International Lacrosse Development web page - www.icfld.com under LOGO HUNT.
4. The winner of this competition will receive VIP treatment at either the 2009 Women's World Cup in Prague, Czech Republic, or at the 2010 Men's World Championships in Manchester, England, and \$500 to cover his or her expenses.
5. The contest begins immediately and your entries* together with the signed Option Contract (found on www.icfld.com) must be sent by March 22nd to Heike Marie Ebel (see contact details below).
6. Following the entry deadline, all entries submitted by this date will be considered by the TB and a short list will be presented to the FIL Board and the General Assembly (GA) for a decision 60 days prior to the initial GA meeting in August 2008. The GA will make the final decision at that meeting.

Conditions

NOTE: All entries must be submitted as color hard copy in good quality *and* in digital form on CD (as .jpg, .gif, .bmp, .psd, or .ai) in order to be considered.

1. Full rights to the logo must be signed over to the unification Transition Board who will be responsible for this until the new body is formally incorporated and then all rights transfer to the new organization.
2. Anybody may take part in the contest under the condition that the Option Contract regarding the acquisition of rights to the logo be signed and returned with the entry.
3. The Option Contract may be found on the Website www.ildc.com under LOGO HUNT as a Download. You must enter your name in the Option Contract and sign both relevant sections.
4. Submitted entries that are not accompanied by a signed Option Contract cannot be considered.
5. Members of the TB may not participate in the contest.
6. Following the entry deadline, all entries submitted by this point will be considered by the TB, and a short list will be presented to the FIL Board and the General Assembly (GA) 60 days in advance of the initial GA meeting in August 2008.
7. The GA will make the final decision at that meeting.
