Breach of FIH Code of Conduct

Match #10 Korea vs. Ireland

Date May 1st 2008

Player # 1 Lim Ju Young

Decision

Player # 1 Lim Ju Young is found to have violated the following Rules and Directives of the FIH Rules of Conduct:

1. Participants shall at all times conduct themselves fairly and properly on the field of play and any part of the hockey venue/accommodation. No person may conduct himself in a manner or commit any act or omission which may prejudice the interest of hockey or which may bring the game of hockey into disrepute.
2. Without prejudice to the generality of the foregoing, the following shall be regarded as conduct which is improper, unfair, and unacceptable:
 - (a) Verbal/physical abuse or hostility towards any other participant, person or any other member of the public.

It is my opinion that this is a Level 3 offence, because there was physical assault causing bodily injury to another player.

Due to all the facts and findings my decision is as follows:

1. Lim Ju Young # 1 of the Korean Team is suspended for five matches.
2. The suspension will begin from May 2nd 2008.
3. It should be applied to the next International World level event.
4. To complete the suspension the player must be a member of the Korean team.
5. That this be referred to the Honorable Secretary General of the FIH for further consideration of the Judicial Commission.
